

This chapter introduces numerous new concepts. Form the class up into teams of 3 to 4 members each. Each team should select about 25 "words" or "concepts" from the chapter and construct a crossword puzzle. Be sure to be creative with your word clues - don't just use the exact definition from the book - be clever and cryptic! You can find numerous "robots" on the internet that will automate the construction of the puzzle, once you provide the clues and responses.

As time permits, share your team's puzzle with the other teams. It is a very good exercise to work one or two puzzles together in class (by projecting the puzzle on a screen and calling for input from classmates). Don't forget this is a learning exercise, so be sure to discuss the significance of the clues.
